

4.5 CONCLUSIONS AND RECOMMENDATION

We believe the proposed work would not contravene the Conservation Guidelines developed for the Conservation Management Plan for the place' and would involve only the removal of intrusive elements known not to be part of Greenway's original design, and to allow the place to be usable in the future.

Over time Cleveland House has suffered numerous forms of desecration to its classical architecture that should not have been tolerated and certainly not supported in any form.

The works proposed would also provide much-needed period building material to assist in the restoration of the main house.

On the above grounds we believe the proposal can and should be approved.
